SCOPE OF WORK

1- Objective

The project aims to enhance agricultural sustainability in vulnerable communities using permaculture for climate resilience. It involves young people, runs community awareness campaigns, and utilizes permaculture techniques for effective water management. Additionally, it engages local stakeholders to tailor project technologies to their specific needs and conducts educational programs about climate change and sustainable farming.

2- Training Topics

The below topics should be developed following **Permaculture**, **Climate Change**, and **Sustainable Agriculture** criteria however they are subject to change according to needs assessment and curriculum development results.

- Sustainable Agriculture Principles
- Climate-Smart Agriculture
- Application of Data and Technology in Agriculture
